MARCH.

THE **SPRING CUP** WAS FISHED ON THE 4TH THE WEATHER ON THE DAY WAS COOL. IT WAS MID AFTERNOON BEFORE SOME OLIVES APPEARED AND A CDC OLIVE WAS USED TO GOOD EFFECT DURING THIS SPARSE HATCH. SMALL BEAD HEADS PRODUCED FISH ALSO .THE EVENT WAS WON BY **TONY DOHERTY** (4 FISH FOR 2 LBS 8 OZS) 2ND **NORMAN MORROW** (4 FISH FOR 2 LBS 4 OZS) 3RD WAS **PETER DOHERTY** (4 FISH FOR 1 LB 12 OZS) THE WEATHER REMAINED CHANGEABLE FOR THE MONTH

BEST FLIES DURING THE MONTH WERE SMALL DRY OLIVES AND OLIVE NYMPHS AND BLACK NYMPHS.

<u>APRIL.</u>

THE WEATHER IMPROVED DURING THE SECOND WEEK OF APRIL AND OLIVES BEGAN TO APPEAR. IT WAS DURING THIS SPELL OF GOOD WEATHER THAT THE WET & DRY TOOK PLACE. THERE WAS A VERY GOOD TURNOUT FOR THIS EVENT **DENIS GOULDING** RETURNED FROM THE USA BORROWED A ROD FROM PETER DOHERTY AND WENT ON TO WIN THE COMPETITION WITH 4 FISH (FOR 2 LBS 11 OZS)**KEVIN DUNNE** FINISHED 2ND (4 FISH 2 LBS 7 OZS)AND **TONY DOHERTY** 3 RD (4 FISH 2LBS 2 OZS) THE MONTH OF APRIL ON THE RIVER WAS FOR THE MOST PART PRODUCTIVE, BEST FLIES WERE DRY OLIVES ,BLACK NYMPHS AND CLARET KLINKHAMMER

<u>MAY.</u>

THE **GRAY CUP** COMPETITION TOOK PLACE ON THE 6 TH. **TERRY WALSH** WON THE EVENT (4 FISH 2 LBS 12 OZS) 2ND WAS **TONY DOHERTY** (4 FISH 2LBS 7 OZS) 3 RD WAS **KEVIN DUNNE** (4 FISH 2 LBS 6 OZS)

THE WEATHER WAS GOOD DURING THE EARLY PART OF THE MONTH BUT IT TOOK A TURN FOR THE WORST MID MONTH WITH WET AND UNSETTLED CONDITIONS. DURING THIS PERIOD THE MAIN HATCH WAS OF IRON BLUES

<u>JUNE.</u>

THE **MICHAEL O'REILLY** TROPHY WAS FISHED ON THE 2ND. CONDITITIONS WERE POOR ON THE NIGHT WET AND WINDY. HOWEVER **PETER DOHERTY** CHOSE THE RIGHT LOCATION ON THE NIGHT (BELOW THE POWER LINES) AND WENT ON TO WIN THE COMPETITION WITH 4 (FISH FOR 2LBS 5 OZS) **PAT CLEERE** FINISHED 2ND (4 FISH FOR 2 LBS 2 OZS) AND **TERRY WALSH** WAS 3 RD (2 FISH FOR 1LB 2 OZS) PETER WAS ALSO IN ACTION IN SCOTLAND ON THE INTERNATIONAL RIVER TEAM DURING THE MONTH. JUNE WAS TO REMAIN A WET MONTH AND FISHING WAS DIFFICULT DUE TO CONSTANT FLOODING.

<u>JULY.</u>

FISHING WAS DIFFICULT DURING THE MOMTH DUE TO FLOODING AND HEAVY RAIN. IT WAS VERY MUCH A CASE OF BEING IN THE RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME..

THE **TWILIGHT COMPETITION** WAS FISHED ON THE 7 TH. THE RISE ON THE NIGHT WAS POOR.

TONY DOHERTY WON THIS EVENT 4 FISH(2 LBS 100ZS) **KEVIN DUNNE** TOOK 2ND PLACE 4 FISH (1LB 14 OZ) AND **KEVIN TIPPER** FINISHED 3RD 4(FISH 1LB 110ZS)

<u>AUGUST.</u>

THE **AUTUMN CUP** WAS FISHED ON THE 12^{TH} THE EVENT WAS WON BY **KEVIN DUNNE** 4 FISH (2LBS 80ZS) **TONY DOHERTY** TOOK 2^{ND} (4 FISH 2LBS 50ZS) AND **PAUL DUNNE** FINISHED 3^{RD} (3 FISH 1LBS 90ZS)

THE WEATHER FOR MOST OF THE MONTH WAS VERY CHANGEABLE WITH HIGH WATER FOR MUCH OF THE TIME.

<u>SEPTEMBER .</u>

THE CHANGEABLE WEATHER CONTINUED INTO THE FIRST WEEK OF THE MONTH. THE **HARRY SMITH CUP** WAS FISHED ON THE 2^{TH}

PETER DOHERTY WON THE EVENT WITH 4 FISH (2LB 70ZS) 2ND **JOE DOHERTY** WITH 3 FISH (1LB 150ZS) AND **PAUL DUNNE** FINISHED 3 RD 3 FISH (1LB 50ZS)

THE WEATHER DID IMPROVE DURING THE MONTH BUT FLY LIFE WAS VERY POOR AS A RESULT THE FISHING WAS VERY PATCHY.

IN LATE SEPTEMBER PETER DOHERTY WAS REWARDED FOR HIS CONSISTANCY ON THE RIVER BY WINNING THE ITFFA NATIONAL RIVER CHAMPIONSHIP

THE COMPETITION WAS FISHED ON THE RIVER ANNALEE IN CAVAN 20 ANGLERS FISHED ON THE DAY 5 FROM EACH PROVINCE. 203 MEASURABLE TROUT WERE CAUGHT. PETER WILL BE PART OF THE IRISH INTERNATIONAL TEAM FISHING THE RIVER TAFF IN WALES THIS YEAR

DECEMBER.

OUR CHRISTMAS OUTING WAS HELD IN RATHCON FISHERY 20 MEMBERS TOOK PART. THE WEATHER ON THE DAY WAS MILD BUT VERY WET. 
